16 to 19 tuition fund: 2021 to 2022

Online Statement

UTC Plymouth has opted in for the 16 - 19 tuition fund: 2021 to 2022 provided by the Department for Education.

The additional funding for 2021/2022 will be used to enable UTC Plymouth students aged 16 - 19 without a level 4 or above in GCSE maths and/or English to achieve at least a pass in their GCSE resits. Raising attainment will remove barriers to students' next steps in education and entering the workplace. The funding will be utilised through small maths and English classes with qualified teachers. There will also be an offer of 1 to 1 tutoring sessions with students who are most in need of support with a focus on our SEND students. Additionally, funding will be allocated to purchasing revision guides, maths and English resources, printing costs and equipment. This equipment includes: calculators, compasses, pens, pencils, exercise books, erasers and tracing paper. There will also be funds used for running sessions on wellbeing, revision and exam techniques and building confidence to give our students the best possible support to excel.
